All of which are substantially lighter than what we have ever made before in Legacy range, but at the same time they are as comfortable, trendy, high quality and prepared for "Hygge" as you expect from a Nordisk tent or tarp.

All Minis pack perfectly into the specially designed rucksacks Yggdrasil and Ygg and enable you to head off into nature to enjoy your own adventure!

And to spice up the concept further, we have made space for your own creativity, enabling you to style and colour your camp exactly as you would like it to be!

We call the concept: Colour my Adventure.



The Concept

Personalizing tents now starts at the shop – which colour(s) do you like?

Each Mini tent & tarp comes in two packages. One of them holding the Mini tent or tarp itself – the shell – and the other one - the Colour Pack - holding all essential accessories you would need for set-up – the poles, the pegs and the guy lines. With this creative split we offer you a great variety of coloured add-on-parts you can choose from and equip your Mini tents and tarps with. And if you want to change something about your Mini tent or tarp – you can just go for another Colour Pack for your existing tent or tarp and re-invent your camp easily!

The best of two worlds - light in weight, yet comfortable and cosy.

With the new Mini tents & tarps we have taken the best ideas from our Nordisk Legacy tents and our Nordisk Leisure range and created a whole new fabric & material concept. We substantially reduce weight and packing size, but maintained comfort and stability. For our "Colour My Adventure" range we found a one-off mix of lightweight aluminium poles, pegs & trims and lightweight, rain resistant fabrics which all have a nice cotton look and feel to them.



BUILD UP INSTRUCTION - ASGARD TECH MINI

1 Bring your Asgard Tech Mini tent and your Asgard Mini Colour Pack - or your Colour Packs, if you have more than one - to the camp site. Take the tent out of its packsack and all poles, pegs and guy lines from the Colour Pack. Set aside the 2 clotheslines and the zipper pullers in the colour kit for the final assembly stage.

Tent in packsack




Footprint




Do not forget to bring at least one Asgard Mini Colour Pack, as it contains all essential accessories needed for the tent set-up.

Colour pack




2 Spread out the tent on an even surface without any sharp objects. If you have the matching footprint*, spread footprint out first - and afterwards the tent above it. Attach all 8 ground fixation corner D-rings to the ground using the tent pegs from the Colour Pack.


Take all guy lines from the colour kit and attach them to the roof flap webbing loops by using the mini hook on each guy line.




E Open the main door and the mesh door behind it. Take the thicker center pole from the colour kit and insert it into the internal TurtleHub pole pocket at the top center point of the tent. Put the pole foot down on the reinforced spot on the tent floor.




1. Center pole pocket



2. Pole foot on reinforced spot




4 Take the 2 door poles into the tent and insert the first one into one of the the designated TurtleHub pockets on the inside of the tent above the door. Afterwards put the opposite pole end into the pole rest pocket on the tent floor. Do the same with the second door pole. Finally pull out the external guy line above the door and peg out to the ground for stabilising the tent entrance.




5 Now, pull out all remaining pre-attached guy lines and peg them out to the ground. Adjust position of attached triangle pocket for camp safety. Attach all mud skirt cord loops to the peg point of the D-rings.

6 Please note: All guy lines are adjustable in length. When you set up the tent for the first time, all guy lines are set to perfect peg-out length. We recommend to set them back to this length and put them into the attached storage pockets every time you take down the tent and leave camp. In doing so, you are best prepared for the next set-up.




- Asgard Tech Mini features an extendable front door. In „flat-door-mode“ the extender flap is rolled up behind the two zippered door flaps. In „extended mode“ the extender flap is rolled out, zipped in and pegged out - creating a vestibule area in front of the bathtub floor area of the tent. Here you can store your wet gear and dirty boots, for example.

Now for the finishing touches! Your Colour Pack contains 2 clotheslines and a pack of nice Nordisk zipper pullers. Attach the clotheslines above the door, at the top center point and at the rear wall of the tent, using the pre-attached mini hooks. Each clothesline is equipped with two O-ring hangers for hanging torches or other light gear. The zipper pullers can be put onto every zipper slider of the tent to make your tent even more colourful.



Last step: Let some air into your tent, if needed. Asgard Tech Mini is equipped with two mesh windows that can be opened and closed from the inside of the tent by pulling the two straight window zippers down or up. Open the windows full or half - the zippers allow for any cover flap position and ventilation intensity.

TAKE CARE OF YOUR NORDISK MINI TENT

In the Camp

- make sure you pitch on an even and big enough surface
- remove sharp rocks and sticks that could harm the tent floor
- stretch the tent as much as possible for optimal strength and water repellency
- if wet or very windy, you need to re-adjust the tension of the guy ropes
- if very windy, use extra guy ropes and pegs for stability
- put the packsack somewhere where you can find it again
- avoid fire and smoke near the tent – be aware of wind directions!
- keep an eye on guy rope tension once in a while
- remove all traces of your camp when you go



Living with your tent

- do not use any sort of coating – a clean tent has the best water repellency
- keep it clean with a soft sponge or brush
- use no harsh chemical cleaning or machine washing
- keep it dry, and if packed down wet, remember to dry it as soon as possible – remember that a wet tent is heavier than a dry one
- store in dry surroundings
- check guy ropes and pegs once in a while, and buy new ones if damaged
- if you have damaged poles, your local Nordisk dealer can supply new ones
- be aware that long exposure of sunlight can degrade the fabric
- love and nurse your tent. If you protect your tent, it will protect you
